



Standard Plan Preventive Medications List

This list below is your plan's preventive medications per the Affordable Care Act (ACA). These medications are being covered at a zero copay per your plan. Some are Over the Counter (OTC) medications. All of these medications will require your doctor to write a prescription for them to be covered by your plan.

Please check with your plan administrator if you have questions.

Aspirin – OTC 81mg and 325 mg for males age 45 through 79 and females age 55 through 79

Smoking cessation products – some OTC and some Rx products for adults greater than or equal to age 18

Fluoride – Rx product for children through age 5

Iron supplements – OTC product for infants through 12 months old

Folic acid – OTC product .4 or .8 mg for females through age 50

Contraceptives– Rx oral medications, NuvaRing, skin patch systems, Depo-Provera

Vaccines – Rx products per Recommendations of the Advisory Committee (CDC) on Immunization practices

Vitamin D – OTC and Rx for people age 65 and over in community dwellings

Bowel Preparations – Limit two prescriptions annually for any persons age 49 through 76
